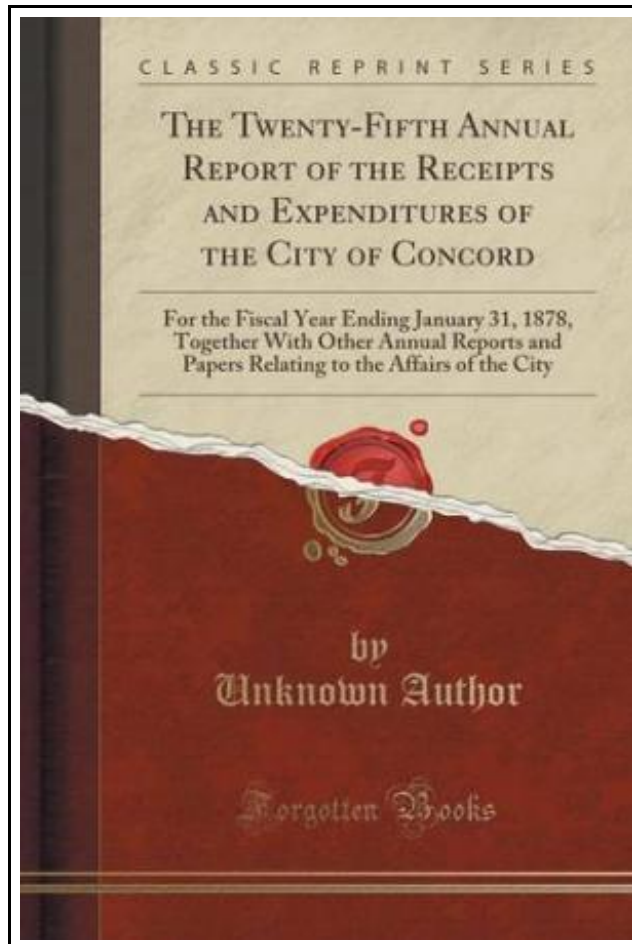

Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from The Twenty-Fifth Annual Report of the Receipts and Expenditures of the City of Concord: For the Fiscal Year Ending January 31, 1878, Together With Other Annual Reports and Papers Relating to the Affairs of the City To persons having claims against the City: All persons furnishing materials or service for the city, or aid to city paupers, should be particular to take the name of the person ordering such service, material, or aid, and should know that the person is duly authorized to contract said liability. The city will not be holden for merchandise sold or delivered on city pauper account, except on the written order of the Overseer of the Poor, and for no longer time than until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified. Duplicate copies will be required of all bills payable by the city, furnished on county pauper account. All bills against the city must be approved by the person authorizing the charge; and unless this is done, no action can be had upon the bill by the committee on accounts, and no order will be given for its payment. When bills are certified to as above, and left with the city clerk before twelve o clock of the day of meeting of the Committee on Accounts, they will be audited by them, and, if approved, he ready for payment on the Wednesday following. Meetings of the committee are held on the Thursday next preceding the last Saturday of each month, at two o clock p. m., which will occur the present year, Feb. 21, March 28, April 25, May 23, June 27 July 25, Aug. 29, Sept. 26, Oct....
