The plate is separated from the ribs and chuck by cutting through the ribs on a line beginning about the middle of the rib next to the hind quarter and running parallel to the backbone to the point where the shank is removed. If the line or cut be nearer the backbone, the ribs are short, more desirable, and higher priced. Ribs are usually separated from chucks by cutting across the backbone between the fifth and sixth ribs, counting from the front backwards. Ribs usually include about eight ribs, two of which have part of the shoulder blade in them. The prices quoted for ribroast are for cuts of ribs that do not have any part of the shoulder blade in them. Some firms in some cities cut ribroast short and trim off part of the chine bone before weighing. Chucks extend from the...



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
